



World Genius Search Examination Global Genius Awards – 2021 Application Procedure for Students

1. Introduction

World Genius Search Examination (WGSE) is the well-accepted global platform for caliber measurement, right observations, precise assessment, and decision making. WGSE is currently open to Grade / Class 1 to 10. It will get extended to post graduate level from 2023 – 24.

2. Global Genius Awards 2021

WGSE is the Global Benchmark Test which explores the ability of a student to derive good logic and apply Mathematics and Science for right decision-making. All the **100 percentile scorers** of WGSE 2021 from each Grade / Class will be conferred with **Global Genius Awards 2021**.

3. The WGSE Scores: GPS & GII

Apart from Global Genius Awards, WGSE offers two scores.

a. Global Percentile Score™ (GPS)

Global Percentile Score (GPS) is the Grade / Class wise score offered globally every year. Though GPS is the primary score confined to the respective years, the second score is more precious than GPS due to its wider applications and analysis.

b. Global Intellectual Index™ (GII)

Global Intellectual Index is the most sought-after caliber measurement score derived from all the WGSE participating years. It has detailed analysis too. GII is offered on a scale of 0 to 9. Consistent WGSE participation ensures more reliable and precise GII as it is calculated using all the scores a student scored in WGSE from the base (first) year to current year. Please read the explanatory note below.

c. GII: Scope & Applications

As GII is a derived score from all the WGSE scores, it can be effectively used for various applications including campus recruitments, proficiency assessment, educational loans, admissions to various Universities, International Recognition & Scholarships. It acts as the Credible Caliber Index in Academics and Career. WGSE will be extended to Graduate and Post Graduate Courses from 2023 - 24.

To get more clarity on GII, Consider this example. When a student participates in WGSE from Grade / Class 1 and appears for WGSE at the final year of Graduation, the GII Score can be 15 Y – 8.12345. Here, 15 Y indicates the number of participating years without any break and 8.12345 indicates the precise caliber score drawn from the Global Percentile Scores (GPS) of all those 15 years.

4. WGSE 2021: Online

Considering the prevailing pandemic condition across the world, we have decided to introduce online mode for WGSE – 2021 for the convenience of Schools and Students.

In the online mode, WGSE 2021 will be scheduled for two days and schools can opt a date. Students can take it online either from school or home using a smart phone or laptop.

5. Career Aptitude & Recognition Test - CARTest (Only for 9 & 10)

Many students and parents who enjoyed WGSE requested us for the right guidance for career selection. This prompted us to design the Career Aptitude & Recognition Test – CARTest. It identifies strengths, limitations and weakness of a student apart from the aptitude towards various careers. Identifying the weakness can help the student to go for remedial measures to bring it to positive territory.

It analyses the student's capacity of knowledge and the knowledge possessed. CARTest scans their judging ability, understanding and reasoning power. It helps the student to choose the right path for their career without narrowing down the available options. A combined option at concessional fee for WGSE 2021 & CARTest is available. Please refer Point 8.d below.

6. Syllabus & Pattern of WGSE 2021

Important: Kindly note that WGSE 2021 Syllabus will be the full academic year syllabus of AY 2020-21 (i.e. last year). Hence current Grade / Class 1 cannot write WGSE 2021; whereas they can appear for WGSE 2022 which is to be held in January 2022.

For example, a student currently in Grade / Class 10 will be having the Class 9 Syllabus for WGSE 2021 as explained below. Questions are mainly from Mathematics and Science of the respective Grade / Class; but connected to daily life experiences and applications. The higher classes will have questions from IT, English and Logic too.

WGSE Question Paper consists of objective questions only. The following is the Structure of the Question Paper.

7. Register Grade / Class 1 students with nominal fee/without fee for WGSE 2022

Important Note:

When more than 50 students from your school register for WGSE 2021 (to be held in Sept 21), you can register all Grade / Class 1 students for WGSE 2022 (to be held in January 22), for a nominal fee or without any fee, irrespective of the number of students.

8. Fee Structure, Exemptions & CARTest

a. Fee structure for current Grade / Class 1: WGSE 2021

Students who are studying for Grade / Class 1 during this Academic Year (2021-22) are not eligible for WGSE 2021. They may register for WGSE 2022 which will be held by the end of January 2022.

Please refer Point No. 6 & 7 on syllabus, its completion and **NO FEE** proposal.

b. Fee structure for current Grade / Class 2: WGSE 2021

c. Fee structure for current Grade / Class 3 to 10: WGSE 2021

d. Combined Fee of WGSE 2021 & CARTest for current Grade / Class 9 & 10

1. India: As you know, the Fee for WGSE in India is Rs. 700 and CARTest is Rs. 1200 (available for Grade / Class 9 & 10 only). The total Fee for both comes to 1900 = 700 + 1200. But if students opted for both - WGSE & CARTest, we give concessional fee of Rs. 1500; less by Rs. 400 from the actual fee. Students may opt for the combined option, if they desire.
2. Other Countries: Fee for WGSE outside India is Rs. 1200 and CARTest is Rs. 1500 (available for Grade / Class 9 & 10 only). The total Fee for both comes to 2700 = 1200 + 1500. But if students opted for both - WGSE & CARTest, we give concessional fee of Rs. 2200; less by Rs. 500 from the actual fee.

9. Key Dates for WGSE 2021

Closing Date for WGSE 2021 Registrations: **Tuesday, 14 December 2021**

Test Dates: WGSE 2021 will be held on **Sat, 18 December 2021**

WGSE 2021 Results: The Results will be announced on **Monday, 3rd January, 2022**

Class wise Test schedule will be intimated to schools and students by **Thursday 16th December, 2021.**

11. Fee Collection and Registrations by Schools and Students

- a) Schools can circulate the online fee payment link/s given by us (through mail) among students. Students can pay the fee online and it will come directly to us with the **WGC School Code allotted by us** against the Affiliation Number. Note that the Affiliation number is **NOT** the WGC School Code.
- b) After the closing date for registrations, we can send the students list to the school. **Schools need to fill the SCHOOL APPLICATION FORM (SAF) and mail to worldgeniuscouncil@gmail.com** with a copy to wgse@worldgenius.global
- c) Though students use online mode for registrations and to take WGSE 2021, the consolidated results, certificates, medals & trophies will be dispatched to the respective school for distribution among students.
- d) Students can view their own individual results after the announcement date.

12. WGC School ID

A comprehensive revamp is done on WGC School ID to accommodate various global parameters and to make it scalable. Now it is 8 digit numbers beginning with ISO UN M49 Numerical Code. For example, the code for India is 356. Indian schools will have their IDs starting with 35600001, 35600002 so on. We have already mailed you the new ID. If you do not know your New School ID, please write to us – worldgeniuscouncil@gmail.com

13. WGC Student ID in India

To make it easier, in India, students can go for voluntary use of their 12 digit Aadhaar Number prefixed with the Indian code 356 to make it 15 digits. Please note that we use the number only. No proof or verification required. This is to ensure that the student can remember the ID easily.

If students are not having the Aadhaar Number or not willing to use it, leave the student ID blank and we can allot it later.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. Kindly ensure that all students who appeared for WGSE 2020 (last year) are appearing this year too, to keep the validity of their GII score which is derived from all their WGSE Scores. Any break in continuous participation will lapse the validity of their GII score.
2. Please ensure that the WGC Student ID of the earlier students (last year) will remain the same and use it to fill the Fee payment form to draw earlier score to calculate new GII. Hence students used school wise student ID last year should use the same this year too.
