## Application Procedure for Schools

### 1. Introduction

World Genius Search Examination – WGSE is introduced on a global platform after 12 years of brainstorming and analysis for precise assessment and caliber measurement. WGSE is currently open to Grade / Class 1 to 12. It will get extended to post graduate level from 2020 – 21.

#### 1.1. Global Genius Awards 2019

WGSE is the Global Benchmark Test used for caliber measurement and to locate genius across the globe. It explores the ability of a student to apply Mathematics and Science for right decision-making. All the **100 percentile scorers** of WGSE 2019 from each Grade / Class will be conferred with **Global Genius Awards 2019**.

#### 1.2. Key Dates

#### 1.3. Fee Structure and Exemptions

The following fee exemptions are available :

1. All those who have scored 98 percentile and above for WGSE 2018 can participate WGSE 2019 without paying any fee.
2. All those who register for WGSE 2019 before **20<sup>th</sup> December 2018** can avail the '**Advantage Fee**' facility by paying Rs. 600 in India and USD 15 (Rs. 1000) outside India.

**Note:** \* indicates that the school has to print the question papers send by us through email as password protected pdf files. If the school requires printed question booklets to be couriered to them, they need to remit Rs. 600 per student.

#### 1.4. The Scores: GPS and GII – Global Intellectual Index

WGSE – 2019 leads to prestigious **Global Genius Awards**™ with two Global Scores:

##### **Global Percentile Score™(GPS)**

GPS is the Grade / Class wise Global Percentile Score is offered on the global platform. All the WGSE participants with 100 percentile scores are conferred with Global Genius Awards 2019.

##### **Global Intellectual Index™ (GII)**

Global Intellectual Index is the most sought after caliber measurement score with detailed analysis. GII is offered on a scale of 0 to 9 and is drawn from the Global Percentile Scores of all the WGSE participated years, without any break. Consistent WGSE participation ensures more reliable and precise GII, calculated from the base year 2018.

To get more clarity on GII, Consider this example. When a student participates in WGSE from Grade / Class 1 and appears for WGSE at the final year Graduation, the GII Score can be 15 Y – 8.12345. Here, 15 Y indicates the number of participating years without any break and 8.12345 indicates the precise caliber score drawn from the Global Percentile Scores of all those 15 years.

#### 1.5. GII: Scope & Applications

As GII is a derived score from many years, it can be effectively used for a wide range of applications including campus recruitments, proficiency assessment, educational loans, admissions to various Universities, International Recognition & Scholarships. It acts as the Credible Caliber Index in Academics and Career. WGSE will be introduced for Graduate and Post Graduate Courses from 2020.

#### 1.6. School Rating & Grading from 2021

World Genius Council will start Rating & Grading of Schools, Colleges and Universities from 2021. Please note the following points and prepare your school for getting the right grading in

2021. This is not publicly announced and therefore, it is not given at our website. This information is shared only with the schools which took part in WGSE 2018.

1. Year wise performance and improvement of students in WGSE Results for three previous years will be used as one of the tools to grade the Schools and Universities from 2021.
2. Hence WGSE scores of 2019, 2020 and 2021 will be considered for Rating & Grading the Schools.
3. Schools should enroll either 100 students or 10% of the total school strength (whichever is higher) for WGSE to become eligible for Rating & Grading.
4. To support your school for the above, you are allowed to register all Grade / Class 1 students without paying any fee provided the school has more than 100 paid registrations from class 2 to 12 for WGSE 2019.
5. Please read **the instructions attached with this letter** to register Class/ Grade 1 students without paying any fee.

### **1.7. Eligibility**

World Genius Search Examination™ - 2019 (WGSE) is currently open to all students those who are studying for Grade / Class 1 to 12 under various curricula across the globe. WGSE will be extended to Post Graduate level from 2020 - 21.

### **1.8. Venue**

## **2. How Schools Register Students for WGSE 2019**

### **2.1. STEP – I : Collect the Registration Fee from students:**

Collect the fee from the students as it is indicated under heading number 1.3. Please note the closing date if you are interested to take the '**Advantage Fee**' facility.

### **2.2. STEP –II: Remit the Fee**

Complete the School Participation List (in the excel format) and Consent Form (SPL) with students' details. It can be downloaded from the Download Center of the website.

Out of the fee collected, the school should retain the test administration expenses for the school as mentioned in paragraph 1.3. Remit the balance fee to the account of the WGSE administrator – **World Genius Conclave Private Limited**.

The fee can be paid to the WGSE administrator's account in the following ways:

1. Deposit cash in the account of WGSE administering agency at any of the State Bank of India branches across India. Account details are given below.
2. Use NEFT / RTGS / SWIFT/ Net banking to transfer the fee to the WGSE administering agency
3. By sending a Demand Draft / Multicity Cheque, favouring **World Genius Conclave Private Limited**, payable at par across India. (We do not prefer DD since there can be delay in issuing receipts, subject to realization of the same.)

Send the completed SPL along with the Demand Draft / Proof of Fee payment to the address given in the next column.

### 2.4. Check List

1. Duly filled-in and correctly named School Participation List (SPL - 2019) in Excel format through email.
2. Scanned copy of (a) Cash Deposit slip or (b) RTGS / NEFT Reference ID (UTR No.) or (c) Demand Draft.
3. In case of Demand Draft, a Photocopy of the same is also to be enclosed, stapled to the School Participation List.

Keep a copy of the documents before you send it. Note that application without any of the three items above will be considered incomplete and shall not be processed further without completion.

## 3. Accreditation, WGC IDs & Syllabus

### 3.1. ACFIO Recognition & Higher Credibility

WGSE is the first and the only Genius Search Examination / Olympiad accredited by Accreditation Council for International Olympiads (ACFIO). No other Scholarship examinations or Olympiads are accredited by ACFIO for quality and credibility.

### 3.2. Syllabus

Syllabus is mainly connected to Mathematics and Science of the respective class. Please download the same from the downloads section of our website.

### 3.3. WGC School ID

A comprehensive revamp is done on WGC School ID to accommodate various global parameters and to make it scalable. Now it is 8 digit numbers beginning with ISO UN M49 Numerical Code. For example, the code for India is 356. Indian schools will have their IDs starting with 35600001, 35600002 .... so on. We have already mailed you the new ID. If you do not know your New School ID, please write to us – [response@worldgenius.global](mailto:response@worldgenius.global)

### 3.4. WGC Student ID

Schools can allot WGC Student IDs to student using their New School ID. The new 8 digit School ID followed by 7 digits starting from 0000001. Hence, the school with School ID 35600001 can allot 356000010000001, 356000010000002 ... .. Please note that all existing STUDENT IDs will be replaced by us using the same criteria and we will inform this to schools.

To make it easier, in India, students can use their 12 digit Aadhaar Number prefixed with India code 356 to make it 15 digits. If they do not have the Aadhaar Number, schools can use the same criteria as given in the first paragraph of 3.4.

All the answer sheets are digitalized from WGSE 2019 and students need not write their 15 digit IDs in the answer sheets as it is customized.
